



Choir / Music Teacher - Full Time

- Applicants should have or be eligible for an Indiana teaching license.

Marian High School challenges students to spiritual and moral growth, academic and physical excellence, and social maturity. As a Catholic community, Marian values the sanctity and individuality of each student and strives to live the example set by Jesus Christ as teacher and servant.

- The Choir / Music teacher position at Marian High School is a full time position. Ideally, candidates would have teaching experience in Choir, Theater, and Instrumental Music.
- Candidates should also be familiar with unit planning, lesson planning, utilizing various forms of formal and informal assessments, differentiated instruction, and techniques for increasing student motivation.
- The Choir / Music teacher is responsible for teaching the Choral Chamber, Musical Theater, Drumline, and the Applied Music courses during the school day. In addition, an ideal candidate would serve a role in the fall play and spring musical as either Assistant Director, Director, or Musical Director. The Choir / Music teacher also directs the Liturgical Choir, which sings at each all school Mass throughout the school year. In addition to these in school activities, there are various out-of-school responsibilities including directing the variety show, performing a fall and spring concert, and supervising students performing at extracurricular contests.
- Bachelor's Degree is required.
- Marian utilizes a standard seven period day. This position would involve teaching five periods.
