

Lectio Divina



The Diocesan Office of Catechesis is sponsoring a three-week session on *Lectio Divina* to be held on Thursday evenings, November 4, 11, and 18, 2010 from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. each evening at St. Mary of the Assumption, Decatur. There will be exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from 3:00 p.m. to 6:45 p.m. on each Thursday of the sessions. The sessions will be facilitated by Richard Reilly. Pope Benedict XVI is asking that Catholics learn to pray *Lectio Divina* saying that this four step process of learning to pray with Sacred Scripture "...will bring to the Church – I am convinced of it – a new spiritual springtime."

Richard will give a history of praying with Sacred Scripture, offer the opportunity to go through the steps and moments of *Lectio Divina* to give guidance to those who are approaching a scriptural prayer life for the first time – or who are looking for a new dimension to their prayer life – learn how to approach and meet Jesus, the Word of God, in Sacred Scripture. Be sure to bring your Bible to each session, as well as a note pad.

Bring your family and friends, and answer the call of the Holy Father to renew this ancient prayer within the life of the Church.
