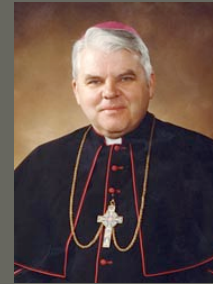

Bishop Emeritus John M. D'Arcy

Bishop D'Arcy was born on August 18, 1932, the son of Irish immigrants. He began preparation for the priesthood in September, 1949 at Saint John's Seminary in Brighton, Massachusetts. He studied in Rome at the Angelicum from 1965 to 1968 and received his doctorate in spiritual theology in 1968. Bishop D'Arcy then served as spiritual director and professor of spiritual theology at Saint John's Seminary from 1968 to 1985. Originally ordained as Auxiliary Bishop for Boston in 1975, Bishop D'Arcy served as the bishop of Fort Wayne-South Bend from 1985 to 2010.

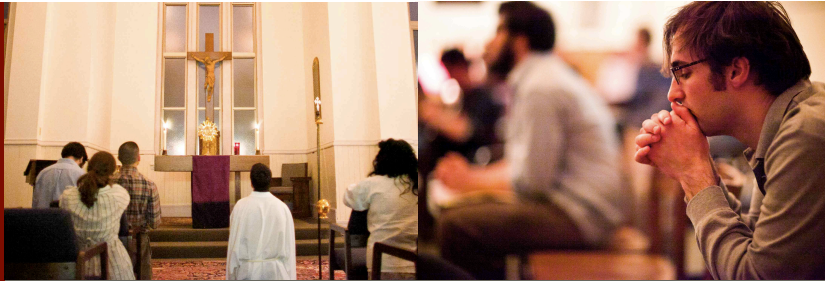

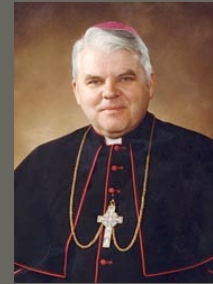
