Notes to instructor:

This assessment (T/F quiz) is required for students in grade three. It is optional for grades one and two. For grade three, give this quiz to the students after the *Good Boundaries Script* presentation. The students may take the quiz up to a week after the presentation.

Please report on FORM 3:

- the number of students who took the quiz
- range of scores (low score high score, either in percent or number correct)
- average score of all students (either in percent or number correct).

For grade 3, the highest score is 6. Both parts of the false question should be correct for the student to earn the point.

Optional way to use the quiz for grades one or two.

For children who have heard the presentation in previous years, begin by having them complete the test. Then go over it, letting the children tell you the correct answers and see what material must be reinforced. Using this method, you will talk over all the main points of the *Script* presentation with them.
